

TRIMS


Trim tiles are finishing pieces that provide a clean execution to tiled floor, walls, windows, ceilings and countertops. Its main purpose is to hide imperfections, protect edges and cover transitions between surfaces.

The New Terracotta tile trims and architectural mouldings series is a compendium of ongoing functional and aesthetic solutions tailored to the projects we have been commissioned.



VICTORIAN BRICKS

This style of brickwork had a surge in popularity during the Victorian and Edwardian eras and was often used on the exterior of train stations, pubs and hotels. Glazed bricks have made a comeback in modern architecture, bringing a stylish and contemporary edge to buildings.

The New Terracotta glazed brick series is offered in historic standard sizes with complementary trim pieces.
